


VICTORIAN ERA




THE MOST IMPORTANT CREATIONS OF DICKENS


A Christmas Carol (1843)



David Copperfield (1850)




Oliver Twist (1838)


CURIOSITIES ABOUT ARTIST

PERSONALITY OF CHARLES DICKENS

- ✘ He is the foremost representative of the Victorian novel. One side of his genius was his natural sense of humour, a quality which has kept alive the characters of his novels up to the present time, when his attacks on the systems of Victorian life have lost their topicality. His humour can be found in character drawing, in dialogue and in whole episodes. The sequence of events that we find in his novels, was partly due to their serial form, and it is to be found particularly in his first great comic novel, *The Pickwick Papers*. Here each episode is pure humour, and Dickens rejoices in his ability to create character after character to put them in funny situations.
